Anyone not registered as part of a membership must have a guest pass.

Dues information is included in the mailing. **Payment is due upon receipt. Envelopes with dues checks must be postmarked by May 1 to avoid a late payment fee.**

Payments postmarked May 2 - May 27 should include a \$40 late fee.

Payments postmarked May 28 or later, please add the late fee of \$80.

Memberships with dues unpaid as of May 28 will be delinquent for the 2017 season. Delinquent

memberships may not be used, sold or transferred until the dues are brought current.

There is a \$12 fee for returned checks.

Please note that termination forms must be received by May 1st or you will be responsible for 2017 dues.

Coming Soon, LG Summer 2017

With temperatures reaching 80 degrees on March 1st, it must be getting closer to summer at Lee Graham. The Board is busy getting ready to start another great summer while our competitive teams are gearing up for the new season of swimming, diving, tennis and water polo. It won't be long before we are cooking out and enjoying the endless days of summer at Lee Graham.

The Board has been busy during the winter trying to make things perfect for this season. As always, we have been fortunate to have Mike Cook's invaluable assistance with several projects during the off-season. There are some changes that will be obvious on your first visit to the pool such as the work at the end of the competition pool. The roots from the pine trees had pushed up some of the concrete slabs creating a tripping hazard. Mike worked with our regular pool contractor and replaced the concrete while also building a knee wall complete with lights. It is a great addition to the pool area and helps save the pine trees.

We also continue to work on and around the clubhouse as it ages. Twenty years ago, we were able to build the clubhouse at a cost of over \$750,000 without charge to our members by selling the property adjacent to the pool. In the years since we built the clubhouse, we have struggled to establish and fund a capital account. We believe \$500,000 is necessary for the long-term financial stability of the Corporation. Without a long-term

account in that range, we remain vulnerable if we have major infrastructure costs. Our pools are now 62 and 50 years old and we need to be prepared in the event of a major issue. At this point, we cannot fund any major improvements to the facility as that could wipe out the capital account. In a normal year, we spend almost \$90,000 just on maintaining the facility and equipment.

A few years ago, the Board instituted a new requirement for member transfers, requiring new members to make a \$500 capital contribution when they joined. That results in about \$25,000 annually and has allowed the capital account to grow somewhat faster than before. While new members contribute directly to the capital account, contributions from existing members has been limited to small surpluses on the annual budget. That is not sound financial planning. A dues increase is necessary so that we can continue to build the capital account and achieve our goal. With that in mind, the Board has set dues for the 2017 season at \$525 for regular memberships and \$425 for senior memberships.

For at least the last 30 years, the Corporation has paid for all improvements and renovations without any special assessment of members. In our view, asking members to contribute \$25 more annually is a far better way to manage our long-term finances than by budgeting only to meet current operational requirements and making special assessments whenever major repair is needed or a new project is proposed. We

hope that you will feel free to attend our monthly Board meetings if you have comments or questions about this or any other issues. The dates and times of Board meetings are posted on the home page of our website.

We are looking forward to the annual pig roast and other events like movie nights, splash dances or anything that we can get folks to help organize. We will have more information about these events in the May newsletter. If you have ideas or just want to help out, please reach out and we'll get things on the calendar.

Please consider helping out at our clean-up day on April 15th. Our facilities at Lee Graham continue to be some of the finest in the area in large part because of your contributions of time and effort to get the facility looking great for opening day. More information on the type of work to be done and how to volunteer is on page 4 of this newsletter.

You can also drop by the pool on April 15th from 1:00pm-3:00pm to have your picture taken for our entry system. New members and those who want to update their pictures are welcome.
